Annotation: This article provides analytical information on the processes of economic development to create favorable conditions for attracting foreign investment in the economy of our country, introducing practical mechanisms for their legal protection and further improving the investment climate.

Currently, one of the most important tasks in the field of economic development is the creation of favorable conditions for attracting foreign investment in the economy of our country, the introduction of practical mechanisms for their legal protection and further improvement of the investment climate.

The investment policy of the Republic of Uzbekistan occupies a leading position among the CIS countries in providing more favorable conditions for attracting foreign investment, building a practical mechanism for reliable legal protection of foreign investment and, on this basis, further improving the investment climate in the country.⁶¹

The goal of the investment policy until 2025 is to increase the competitiveness and balance of the economy, develop the production and export potential, develop the regions and improve the welfare of the population.

The main objectives of the strategy are defined in three main areas: improving the investment climate, expanding domestic sources of investment and improving the efficiency of investment sources, implementing effective measures and developing new approaches to attracting foreign investment.

By 2025, direct investments, including public-private partnerships, public investments and investments in corporate securities, will become the main sources of investment. It plans to use more than 1,002.5 billion soums of decentralized investments in 2019-2025 as part of ongoing and promising new investment projects. In addition, about 30 percent of enterprises will be financed from their own funds.⁶³



Due to direct foreign investments, 4 243.1 billion soums were spent, which, compared to the corresponding period of last year, is more by 1.0 percentage points, or 11.9% of their total volume. High growth rates of utilized investments in fixed assets were observed in the following regions: Bukhara - 151.6% (the volume of utilized investments in fixed assets – 2 670.1 billion soums), Samarkand - 141.1% (2 499.4 billion soums), Andijan - 138.2% (1 816.9 billion soums), Tashkent - 122.6% (4 206.0 billion soums), Syrdarya - 108.5% (1 205.2 billion soums), Fergana - 108.2 % (1 999.6 billion soums) regions.⁶⁵

The least low growth rates of investment activity were observed in Kashkadarya -52.7% (investment volume 2 678.1 billion soums), Navoi - 73.4% (2 859.5 billion soums), Namangan regions - 93.1% (2 180.0 billion soums) and Tashkent city - 96.2% (7 722.4 billion soums).⁶⁶

The economy of Uzbekistan will grow by 1.5% in 2020 and by 6.6% in 2021, which is the highest in Europe and Central Asia. This is stated in the reports of international experts.

Earlier this year, positive economic growth was expected in more than 160 countries around the world. But the spread of the coronavirus pandemic was followed by a global economic and social crisis. As a result, less than half a year later, these economic forecasts changed dramatically.
